Christmas Outreach

With your support, we were able to serve a record number of neighbors in 2022. We provided over 46,000 meals through our kitchen and food box program. 73 individuals were moved into permanent housing, while our Life Skills program hosted close to 500 hours of counseling. In December more than 2,700 children received Christmas assistance through your partnership with our Angel Tree program. Thank you!
